ENTRY

- Entry fee is \$50 for submission of up to three photographs of paintings or sculpture.
- Make checks payable to International Museum of Art.

No Photographs needed to enter

WORKS ELIGIBILITY:

Works submitted must be two or three dimensional and original in concept, design and execution. No computer generated, photographic or printed work will be accepted.

- Maximum size framed is 40" x 50"
- Minimum size framed is 12" x 16"
- Sculpture is not to exceed 125 pounds and not to exceed 24" in any direction.
- Sculpture must be made of a durable medium.
- * Submitted work must not have won an award or entered in previous Sun Bowl shows.
- * Artwork must not be older than 3 years old.

SELECTION and Awards:

- Each artist may enter up to three entries
- Awards to be announced.

- Sales to the Public will be encouraged with the Museum retaining a 40% commission.
- All works submitted must be for sale.

FRAMING:

Artwork must be framed, wired with screw eyes and ready to hang. No saw tooth hangers. No glass Diptych or Triptych to be framed in single frame. Must meet Maximum requirements.

MEDIA:

Oil, acrylic, transparent watercolor, gouache, alkyd, casein, tempera, egg tempera, or other paint media. Works on paper include pastel, pencil, charcoal and colored pencil.

LABELING:

Must include Artist's name, title, medium, size (in inches H .x W.)

Information must correspond with information and numbers on the entry forms.

INSURANCE LIABILITY:

Although the International Museum of Art will exercise due care in handling work, artists must provide their own insurance. The museum cannot assume any liability for loss or damage, however caused. Submission of an entry to this exhibition and/or the signature of the artist on the entry blank provided constitute agreement by the artist to all the terms and conditions which are contained herein.

ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all artists 18 or older. Works of art should not have won prizes locally. The International Museum of Art reserves the right to reject any works not meeting eligibility requirements or deemed inappropriate to hang in the Museum. Acceptance in the Exhibit gives the International Museum of Art the right to photograph or use the submitted photographs for promotional purposes. Entries will remain in the exhibit galleries and cannot be removed before Wednesday, Jan. 5, 2022.

SHIPPING AND RETURNING:

Delivery of accepted paintings to the International Museum MUST be made with shipping charges prepaid or by hand. Paintings and sculpture will be returned prepaid via the same means sent. Hand deliveries must be picked up Wednesday, January 5, 2022, from 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. unless the Museum is otherwise notified.
