April 1, 2023, 1:00 pm- 4:00 pm, Juried by Manuel Guerra, Dr. Melissa Warak, and Tom Birkner.

April 1, 2023. 5:30 pm- 7:30 pm, Reception.

April 23, 2023, Last Day.

April 26 - April 29, 2023, Pick up artwork at El Paso International Museum of Art.

The winners artwork exhibited the following month (May) in the Turney Youth Gallery.

ENTRY

- Please attach the submission form to the artwork and deliver it to
International Museum of Art 1211 Montana Ave. El Paso, Texas 79902
- No charge to enter the event, a collaboration with the El Paso International Museum of Art.

WORKS ELIGIBILITY:

Each artist may submit up to one entry. Work submitted must be two or three-dimensional and original in concept, design, and execution. No computer-generated work will be accepted. Any artwork not following these guidelines will not be accepted.

- Open to students grades 9-12.
- Artwork should follow the event theme: “Small Man in a Vast and Wondrous World” Southwest Landscapes.
- Artwork must not be older than 3 years old.
- All work accepted may be subject to use in promotional materials for the Museum.
- One art piece per student. (Entries are first come, first serve. The exhibition is limited to 80 entries)
- Open to any medium or specified by art teacher.
 - Framed or hangable objects
 - Black matted
 - Label consisting of: Name, Highschool, Year, Title, and Why they were inspired? (1-2 sentences)
 - 18in x18in maximum size
 - Sculpture is not to exceed 125 pounds and not to exceed 24” in any direction and must be made of a durable medium. Pedestals for sculptures are approximately 25 inches.
- Cash prizes: 1st place - \$300, 2nd place - \$200, 3rd place - \$100

SELECTION and AWARDS:

- Each artist may enter up to one artwork. Artists will be notified if they were not selected with information on how to retrieve the artwork.
- Awards to be announced at the reception.

FRAMING:

- The artwork must be ready to hang.
- Must meet size requirements.

MEDIA:

- Oil, acrylic, transparent watercolor, gouache, alkyd, casein, tempera, egg tempera, or other paint media.
- Works on paper include pastels, pencils, charcoal, and colored pencil. Sculpture must be made of a durable medium.
- DSLR and film photographs must be printed.
- Woodcutting, etchings, engravings, lithographs, and screen-printings will be accepted.

LABELING:

- Artworks must include Artist's name, title, medium, size (in inches H .x W.), and what made you inspired to create the piece.

INSURANCE LIABILITY:

Although the International Museum of Art will exercise due care in handling work, artists must provide their own insurance. The museum cannot assume any liability for loss or damage, however caused. Submission of an entry to this exhibition and the signature of the artist on the entry blank provided constitute agreement by the artist to all the terms and conditions which are contained herein.

DROP-OFF AND PICK UP:

Delivery of accepted paintings to the International Museum MUST be given in person. Artwork must be picked up Saturday, April 29, 2023, from 10 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. unless the Museum is otherwise notified.
