The International Museum of Art is proud to be "The People's Museum" and have the distinct opportunity to showcase local art in our community galleries, especially through our annual Sun Bowl Art Exhibit. The Sun Bowl Art Exhibit is a part of the Tony the Tiger Sun Bowl, celebrating the artistic excellence of our community. Beginning in 1949 as the Sun Carnival Art Exhibit, it is one of the longest running juried art shows in the American Southwest. Our 76th annual Sun Bow Art Exhibit will be another stunning showcase of our region's artistic vision, offering the best of our local artists.

The Sun Bowl Art Exhibit does not have a set theme, we encourage each artist to submit work that represents the best of their practice. Artists are welcome to submit up to three (3) works in any media that they believe captures their creativity, artistic merit and vision.

### **ENTRY**

- The entry fee to The Sun Bowl Art Exhibit 2025-2026 is \$60.00 and \$40.00 for Museum Members at the Artist level or higher. Current members are encouraged to upgrade their membership to take advantage of the discount. The entry fee directly supports our mission of making art accessible to all. Payment may be submitted via cash, check, card at the Museum or securely online. Please make checks payable to: International Association for the Visual Arts.
- Payment must be submitted by Wednesday, October 8, 2025 for valid entry.
- Labeled photographs of submissions are required for valid entry.
- Entries must be submitted via <u>mail, Google Forms or in-person</u> to be valid. <u>Emailed entries will not be accepted.</u> Paper copies are available upon request at the IMoA. #### **WORKS ELIGIBILITY:**

Artists are welcome to submit three (3) works of art in <u>The Sun Bowl Art Exhibit 2025-2026.</u> Works submitted must be original in concept, design, execution and created by a singular artist. No AI-created work will be accepted.

- Work does not need to be for sale, but sales to the public are encouraged where the Museum retains a 40% commission. If work is not for sale, please write Not For Sale/NFS on the entry card. If a price is not specified, it will be listed as NFS. Commissions of sold work will be available for pick-up beginning on Thursday, January, 15, 2026.
- All works accepted may be subject to use in promotional materials for the Museum.
- 2-Dimensional work has a <u>minimum</u> framed size of **9h**" **x 9w**" and a <u>maximum</u> framed size of **42w**" **x 84h**."All 2-Dimensional work must have the proper hanging hardware.
- 3-Dimensional work has a <u>minimum</u> size requirement of **4h**" by **4w**" but is not to exceed **150** pounds, **3 ft in diameter or 7 ft in height**, not including the podium.

# **ACCEPTED FORMS OF MEDIA:**

The table below lists some of the, but not all, types of media accepted. Please contact us if you have questions about your work. The IMoA is proud to announce that digital works will be accepted into our galleries, however <u>AI works will NOT be accepted</u>, and <u>works suspected of using AI will be asked to verify the medium.</u>

Medium	Examples		
Paintings	oil, acrylic, watercolor, gouache, tempera or mixed media		
Works on Paper	pastel, pencil, charcoal, marker, colored pencil or mixed media		
Photography	DSLR and film photographs must be printed at the best resolution available		
Printmaking	woodcuttings, etchings, engravings, lithographies, linocuts, screen-printings or mixed media		
3-D/ Installation	paper mache, wood, metal, glass, fiber art, textile, ceramic/pottery, or mixed media.  Must be made of a durable medium and able to support itself/the artist must provide any and all specialized display		
Digital	Works that are painted/illustrated, rendered and edited. Digital works must be printed at the best resolution available		

#### **GALLERY READY:**

Artwork must be ready for display, or gallery ready by **Sunday, October 19, 2025**. All 2-D work must be wired with screw eyes/D-rings and ready to hang. Saw tooth hangers or D-rings without wire are **not** permitted. Please click here to learn how to wire work. All 3-D or installation pieces must be delivered with any specialized display hardware and/or podiums.

While the Museum encourages all artists to frame their work, those who utilize gallery/canvas wrap or whose work extends to the sides of the canvas are not required to use a traditional frame, as long as their





work has the appropriate hanging hardware. Works in series must be contained to a single frame and will be counted as one entry.

In the event a piece requires special installation, the artist will be contacted to install their work. If a piece is discovered to have an issue that would impede its display, it will <u>not be accepted at drop-off</u> until the issue is corrected.

# **SELECTION and AWARDS**

All eligible entrants are welcome to submit three (3) works of art in <u>The Sun Bowl Art Exhibit</u> <u>2025-2026</u>. Artists will be notified by **Thursday**, **October 16**, **2025** of which work has been selected for the show. Awards to be announced.

The International Museum of Art works to ensure at least one work of art by each **eligible** entrant is accepted in the exhibit. The Sun Bowl Art Exhibition is a community exhibition and selection to the show is determined by participation. Due to space constraints and our goal of showcasing a diverse range of artists, the Museum must curate the exhibition so that each artist has a chance to be represented. By making these selections, we can ensure space for all participants while maintaining a high standard of presentation.

#### **INSURANCE LIABILITY:**

Although the International Museum of Art will exercise due care in handling work, artists must provide their own insurance. The museum cannot assume any liability for loss or damage, however caused. Submission of an entry to this exhibition and the signature of the artist on the entry blank provided constitute agreement by the artist to all the terms and conditions which are contained herein.

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Open to all artists 18 or older. The International Museum of Art reserves the right to reject any works not meeting eligibility requirements or deemed inappropriate to hang in the Museum. Any entrant whose submissions are deemed ineligible for the show will be entitled to a refund of their entry fee. Acceptance in the Exhibit gives the International Museum of Art the right to photograph or use the submitted photographs for promotional purposes. Entries will remain in the exhibit galleries and cannot be removed before Sunday, January 11, 2026.

### **DELIVERY AND RETRIEVAL:**

It is the responsibility of the entrant to deliver and retrieve all accepted work to the Museum. Work must be delivered and picked-up during stated designated days and hours. **Artwork will not be accepted after 4:30 pm on Friday, October 24, 2025.** After notifications are sent, entry fee payments are **NONREFUNDABLE.** 

- Artists are allowed to designate a third party to deliver and pick-up their work.
- If you are unable to make the outlined times, contact the IMoA as soon as possible to arrange an alternative.

# **ABANDONED WORK**

Work not retrieved <u>6 months</u> after the designated last retrieval date (July 2026) will be considered abandoned and become property of the IMoA.
